- Regular **patrol** along a road that hunters shoot bats from
- Two **illegal hunters** were deterred in first three days



Proposal to Terengganu State government
to **protect** flying foxes – **12 Jan 2012**

- **Moratorium** on licences for hunting
- Gazette **roost sites** for protection
- **Monitoring and patrolling** in order to enforce moratorium

Terengganu bans hunting of flying fox

PETALING JAYA: There will be no more hunting of Malayan flying fox in Terengganu. The ban follows government decision to stop issuing new hunting licences for the species.

This makes Terengganu the third state in the country to ban hunting of the bat, after Sarawak (in 1998) and Sabah (2010).
